Applicants must be enrolled in full-time studies (at least a 60% course load, or 40% if you have a permanent disability).

Bursaries do not replace expected Government aid. Applicants are expected to apply to the Ontario Student Assistance Program (OSAP), (or another Province's government student assistance program) to help meet education costs.

Bursary decisions are made in conjunction with the assessed need under your Government Student Assistance Plan. If you have not already applied, OSAP applications are available on the Ministry's website: <http://osap.gov.on.ca>

Academic Requirements:

- ∅ Accepted to a recognized post secondary institution (University, College or Trade School).
- ∅ Candidates must have a satisfactory overall academic standing.

Bursary Eligibility:

- ∅ Bursary applicants are eligible to apply for their first and second year post secondary studies.
- ∅ Bursary applicants must have applied for and have been awarded OSAP funding.
- ∅ Bursary applicants must reside within a 15 km radius of Kinmount.

Documents Required:

- ∅ A completed and signed Bursary Application within the specified deadline as stated .
- ∅ Applicant must be a resident within the 15 km radius of Kinmount as evidenced by
 - 1) a copy of your Driver's License showing your current address or
 - 2) a copy of any other Government issued document showing your current address.

Timing of Decisions:

- ∅ Applicants will be adjudicated only after we are able to verify OSAP entitlement or other provincial assistance. Bursary adjudication can take up to one month following the application deadline as stated .
- ∅ All Bursary decisions are final. Appeals will not be considered.
- ∅ Bursary recipients will be notified by Post or email. Any changes to your enrolment and/or course load may result in your Bursary being adjusted or withdrawn.

Payment of Bursary:

- ∅ Bursary payments will be made in two instalments.

- ∅ The first Payments will be sent, upon proof of enrolment at your applicable post-secondary institution and proof of your acceptance for funding by OSAP is received.
- ∅ The second payment will be made, after proof of your enrolment as a student in good standing at your applicable post-secondary institution is received. A photocopy of your marks from the first term and proof of acceptance into the second term must be submitted.
